

Diploma: Master of Science in Philosophy and History of Science

Course title: Philosophy and History of Science

Course description: The MSc course in Philosophy or History of Science covers three semesters of specialised studies as well as a master thesis written during one semester. Depending on the interests of the student, a specialisation in either philosophy or history of science is possible. Innovative learning methods such as special courses with an individual choice of topics and the independent approach to small study projects guarantees for a broad spectrum of education. Next to purely philosophical topics, academic staff members supervise a series of projects about history and theory of all scientific fields. Holders of a master's degree have the possibility to either find employment in different branches and teaching, or else they can complement their academic careers with doctoral studies.
